

## TEMPORARY SAMANERA DAN SIKKHAVATI PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Participant must undergo medical checkup at appointed venue by the committee. It is either at Vihara Jakarta Dhammacakka Jaya, Sunter or Vihara Padumuttara, Tangerang. Registration form, signed by the medical team, should be submitted during the re-enrollment on arrival at Indonesia Satipatthana Meditation Center (ISMC), Bacom.
- 2. Please read the Rules and Regulations for Temporary Samanera and Sikkhavati program attentively.
- 3. Participant must also submit 2 recent photos (size 3x4cm) during the re-enrollment.
- 4. Participant and parent(s)/guardian must sign registration form as well as the rules and regulations document.
- 5. Necessary items that should be brought along with each participant are:
  - a. Stationery, including: book and pens / pencils
  - b. Toiletries (soap, shampoo, tooth paste, tooth brush, towel and hairbrush)
  - c. White T-shirt / Shirt for the opening ceremony
  - d. White underclothes (only for temporary Sikkhavati participants); sufficient underwear, socks and slippers.
  - e. Personal medication(s)
- 6. Participant should wear provided robes neatly.
  - a. Male: Brown Samanera robe.
  - b. Female: Pink Sayalay robe.
- 7. Parent(s)/ nanny/ carer is not allowed to accompany or contact their child during the program. Any concern related to participant can be conveyed through committee.
- 8. Before the program starts, the participant of temporary Samanera and Sikkhavati should learn/memorize the Pali passages of the ordination procedure of Samanera / Sikkhavati (Please refer to <a href="https://www.yasati.com">www.yasati.com</a>).
- 9. During the Temporary Samanera and Sikkhavati Program, all Samanera and Sikkhavati are obligated to shave their heads bald (shaving can be done at ISMC) and implement 10 sila (with one of them including not eating after 12.00 p.m.)
- 10. Participant must maintain cleanliness and tidiness in Dhamma hall, dining hall, bed room and ISMC environment. Please do not move anything out of the room.
- 11. Participant is not allowed to bring cell phone, games, story book(s) and/or food and beverages since the organizer prepares nutritious, healthy and hygienic food.
- 12. Participant must follow rules and regulations of Buddhist Culture Program; if organizer happen to find any violation to the rules and regulations and the participant cannot cooperate during the program, committee have the right to expel that participant from the ongoing program.
- 13. Re-enrollment will be held at 11.00 a.m. in ISMC, Bakom. Lateness without any strong reason may result in committee refusal of registrant participation.
